



GOLF OUTING FUND RAISER

1. Volunteers are the name of the game. Your committee will recruit participants, sell ad space, and solicit auction items. Their hard work will ensure a successful event.
2. Selecting an appropriate club is "THE" major decision. Make sure to do your research and choose your course accordingly. Some public courses may offer lower rates, yet private courses may provide additional amenities.
3. Golf is one of the most heavily sponsored of all sports. Businesses want to connect with people involved with golf. Get local businesses to sponsor your event. Develop a schedule of events to attract good sponsors including player packages, visible signage, participation in an awards ceremony, and prominent listings in marketing and advertisement materials.
4. The club pro will be a general guide for the playing logistics at the course. They will be a great help in your planning process. Many pros will give an instructional clinic as well - a little enhancement to your event.
5. On any typical course the maximum number of foursomes is 27. More than this may slow up play. Golfers like to complete a round in 4.5 to 5 hours. There are playing formats such as "scrambles" or "shotgun starts" that will speed up play. Consider your participants when selecting a playing format.
6. Committee Leaders, KEEP VISABLE! On top of your to do list should be to visit each and every group on the course and thank them. Use your 4.5 to 5 hours of playing time to visit your guests while they are in good spirits and enjoying the day.
7. Everyone enjoys a memento of the day, prizes and recognition awards. This goes a long way to bringing them back next year.
8. Don't forget about the non-golfers! Ask what provisions are available. Maybe a golf clinic or a game of tennis can be provided. Also find out if the facility provides rental clubs for those who do not own them.
9. Consider serving fun foods and beverages under festive tents or canopies placed throughout the course. Popcorn, nachos, cotton candy, pretzels or refreshing beverage from a frozen drink machine will be a welcomed treat.
10. Please be conscious of alcohol consumption during your event and take any precautions to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable time.
